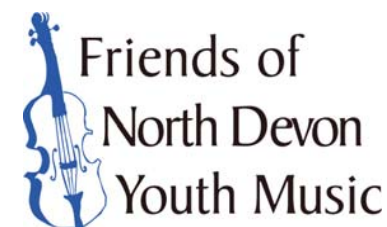

Chi Mai - Ennio Morricone: This piece was used in 'The Life and Times of David Lloyd George' a TV series in the 1980s.

Palladio - Karl Jenkins: A favourite yet extremely taxing piece on the orchestra both technically and rhythmically.

Wind Band directed by Paul Moulton

Selections from Phantom of the Opera: A selection of songs from the famous Andrew Lloyd Webber musical which is celebrating 25 years of success on the West End. Songs include Phantom of the Opera, Music of the Night, All I ask of You, and many more. The piece features solos from all around the band including Oboe, Saxophone and Trumpet.

Intermediate Strings directed by Keith Chivers

'Fiddlesticks' - Darrell Wade: A catchy tune with the 1st violins playing plenty of notes, backed up by the rest of the orchestra keeping in strict time.

Chinese Dance - Darrell Wade: There is a strong emphasis on spiccato bowing (bouncing the bow), a difficult technique for string players.

Concert Strings directed by Alicia Stolliday

Christmas Round the World (A Carol Suite) by Edward Huws Jones: 'Noel Nouvelet' and 'The Holly and the Ivy'.

Ashokan Farewell by Jay Ungar arranged by Bob Cerulli: Soloist: Ella Townsend. Although this piece was written in the 1980's in America, it has an ancient style rooted in the Scottish Lament.

Brass Ensemble directed by Paul Moulton

Bridge Over Troubled Water: The number 1 hit song from Simon and Garfunkel. The song was number 1 in a staggering 47 countries around the world but was written in the midst of a bitter feud between the 2 musicians. It's still popular to this day although it was written 42 years ago.

The Pink Panther Theme: The popular theme tune from both the Inspector Clouseau films and from the famous cartoon. The piece will feature Tim on Alto Saxophone.

Flute choir directed by Catherine Nicholls

Selection from 'The Sound of Music': by Richard Rodgers, arr. Bill Holcombe and Dris Dorsey. This arrangement includes 'My Favourite Things', 'Do-re-me', 'Sixteen Going on Seventeen', 'Edelweiss' and 'Climb Every Mountain'.

Clarinet Choir directed by Carol Dewis

The Elephant from Carnival of the Animals: by Saint Saens arr. Maurice Bale. This piece is taken from the famous musical suite containing 14 musical portraits of various animals. Dom and Lewis who are the 'fantastic bass section' of the clarinet choir take on the role of the Elephant very effectively!

Elite Syncopations: Scott Joplin arr. Peter Spink. This piece is one of Scott Joplin's famous Rags, one of 50 published by the composer, earning him the title of 'King of the Ragtime'.

You've got a Friend in Me: by Randy Newman arr. C Dewis. This song was written and first recorded by Randy Newman. Originally written as the theme song for the 1995 Disney Pixar animated film Toy Story, it has since become the theme song for its sequels, Toy Story 2 (1999) and Toy Story 3 (2010).
